We are seeking a voice teacher to facilitate our "Songbirds" voice classes for young singers (2nd-5th grade) at our Westlake site (404 Camp Craft Rd., Westlake Hills 78746). Curriculum, training, and teacher support will be provided. Opportunities for teaching private lessons and additional classes are available. Our facility is fully accessible, and all programs are open to students with special needs. We have a dedicated teaching space equipped with tools and supplies needed for group and private instruction.

More about Songbirds:

Songbirds performance class is a group voice class designed specifically for young singers. This course provides a foundation for singing and constructive performance experience. During a 10-week session, singers will learn a new song, while working on breathing techniques, age-appropriate warm up exercises, and other music fundamentals, culminating in a final performance of their piece of music.
